1. USGS Groundwater Quality Presentation – Philip Paitz and Mikaela Cherry, USGS:

Project Manager Philip Paitz and Mikaela Cherry, USGS, presented the 2023 Papio-Missouri River NRD Groundwater Quality Monitoring Results and answered Directors questions. No action was taken by the Subcommittee.

2. Agreement with Omni on Little Papio R-14 Replacement – Martin Cleveland:

Project Manager Martin Cleveland reviewed the Little Papio Creek Levee/Channel Project with the Directors and let them know that OMG Midwest submitted a redevelopment plan to the NRD which is required by USACE for work within 500 ft of a channel/levee project. As part of this plan, they will be installing a new 36-inch diameter storm sewer in the development. The NRD planned on rehabilitating the existing 24-inch diameter culvert with its Culvert Group B project. As a result of the OMG development plans it is now proposed that OMG Midwest install a new 36-inch culvert at the existing 24-inch culvert's location and the Papio NRD will provide a cost reimbursement for the portion of the replacement cost equal to the Papio NRD installing a new 24-inch culvert. Martin presented the proposed Cost Share Agreement with OMG Midwest and answered Directors questions.

• It was moved by Director Fowler and seconded by Director Japp that the Subcommittee recommend to the Board of Directors that the General Manager be authorized to execute the proposed Cost Share Agreement with OMG Midwest Inc. DBA Omni Engineering for Replacement of Little Papio Creek Levee/Channel Project Drainage Structure LP R-14 with a reimbursement maximum not to exceed amount of \$253,656, subject to changes deemed necessary by the General Manager and approval as to form by Papio NRD Legal Counsel.

3. <u>Grant Agreement with NRCS for the Davis Creek Watershed WFPO Project – Terry</u> <u>Schumacher:</u>

Land & Water Programs Coordinator Terry Schumacher reminded the Directors that in October 2021, the Board approved JEO Consulting Group for professional services needed to complete the PIFR for the Davis Creek WFPO project. Terry stated that in July 2024, the District received notice that NRCS approved the Notice of Grant Agreement Award submitted for the Watershed Work Plan in the amount of \$900,853. Terry and Mike Placke, JEO, answered Directors questions.

• It was moved by Director Thompson and seconded by Director Fowler that the Subcommittee recommend to the Board that the General Manager be authorized to execute the Proposed Notice of Grant Agreement Award with the Natural Resource Conservation Service for the Watershed Work Plan in the Davis Creek Watershed WFPO Project in an amount of \$900,853, subject to changes deemed necessary by the General Manager and approval as to form by District Legal Counsel.

4. <u>Amendment No. 1 with JEO Consulting Group for the Davis Creek Watershed WFPO Project</u> <u>– Terry Schumacher:</u>

Land & Water Programs Coordinator Terry Schumacher reviewed the proposed Amendment No.1 with JEO for the Davis Creek Watershed WFPO Project which would bring the total contract not to exceed amount to \$832,510. Terry stated that the NRCS and the District have a proposed grant agreement which outlines that NRCS shall pay 100% of the costs for the Watershed Work Plan. All questions were addressed.

• It was moved by Director Thompson and seconded by Director Fowler that the Subcommittee recommend to the Board that the General Manager be authorized to execute the Proposed Amendment No. 1 with JEO Consulting Group for the Davis Creek Watershed WFPO Project in an amount not to exceed \$803,980 bringing the total contract not to exceed amount to \$832,510, subject to changes deemed necessary by the General Manager and approval as to form by District Legal Counsel.
