Sealed Bids for the construction of the Papillion Creek Regional Detention Site WP-1 Dam and Associated Improvements in Douglas County, Nebraska will be received by Papio-Missouri River Natural Resources District (Papio NRD) at the office of the Papio NRD, located at 8901 South 154th Street, Omaha, NE 68138 until 10:00 A.M. local time on September 24, 2024, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read.

The Project consists of the construction of a dam, roadway, and recreational features between Maple Street and Fort Street, west of 180th Street in Omaha, Nebraska. Quantities include 268,000 cubic yards of embankment for main dam and upstream water quality basin; approximately 13,000 tons of riprap placement; 48 inch diameter RCPP spillway; concrete inlet riser and impact basin structures; approximately 2 miles of 10 foot wide trail; construction of concrete park access road and two parking lots; two kayak launches; emergency boat ramp; picnic shelter; vault toilet structure; in-lake fisheries enhancements; approximately 17,000 feet of woven wire fencing; approximately 70 acres of seeding; and associated site work. Quantities are provided for information only and the Contractor is responsible for the verification of all quantities.
