Re: Modification to USGS Agreement for Platte River Cameras

Following the March 2019 flood event, local NRDs, emergency managers, and City staff have been interested in deploying camera systems and sensors at key locations along the Platte River to directly observe what is happening during potential ice jam and flooding situations. In 2021, cameras were installed along the Platte River at Columbus, Schuyler, North Bend, Fremont and Leshara. In 2022, the District and Lower Platte South NRD and USGS installed three additional cameras at Ashland on the Platte and at Winslow and West Point on the Elkhorn River. These cameras have provided valuable information on ice breakup and movement through the Platte system. A ninth camera is proposed for the Platte River at Louisville.

The USGS has modified the agreement to include installation and maintenance of the Louisville site. An interlocal agreement is proposed between the District and the Lower Platte South NRD to equally share the Louisville costs. The following costs would be added to the original agreement for FY25:

Management recommends that the Subcommittee recommend to the Board of Directors that the General Manager be authorized to execute the proposed Modification to the USGS Agreement for the addition of the Louisville camera to FY25 for the Platte River Camera project, subject to changes deemed necessary by the General Manager and approval as to form by District Legal Counsel.

THE GEOLOGICAL SURVEY, UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR, party of the first part, and the **PAPIO-MISSOURI RIVER NATURAL RESOURCES DISTRICT**, party of the second part, hereby agree to amend the Joint Funding Agreement No. **23NRJFA00260** dated October 1, 2022 as follows:

Paragraph 2(a) is hereby **increased by \$4,450** to read as follows:

(a) \$28,030 by the party of the first part during the period October 1, 2022 to September 30, 2025

Paragraph 2(b) is hereby **increased by \$13,355** to read as follows:

(b) \$58,305 by the party of the second part during the period October 1, 2022 to September 30, 2025

Billing for this agreement will be rendered **quarterly**. Payments of bills are due within 60 days after billing date. If not paid by the due date, interest will be charged at the current Treasury rate for each 30-day period, or portion thereof, that the payment is delayed beyond the due date.
