RE: Sorensen to Girard Trail Construction Bids

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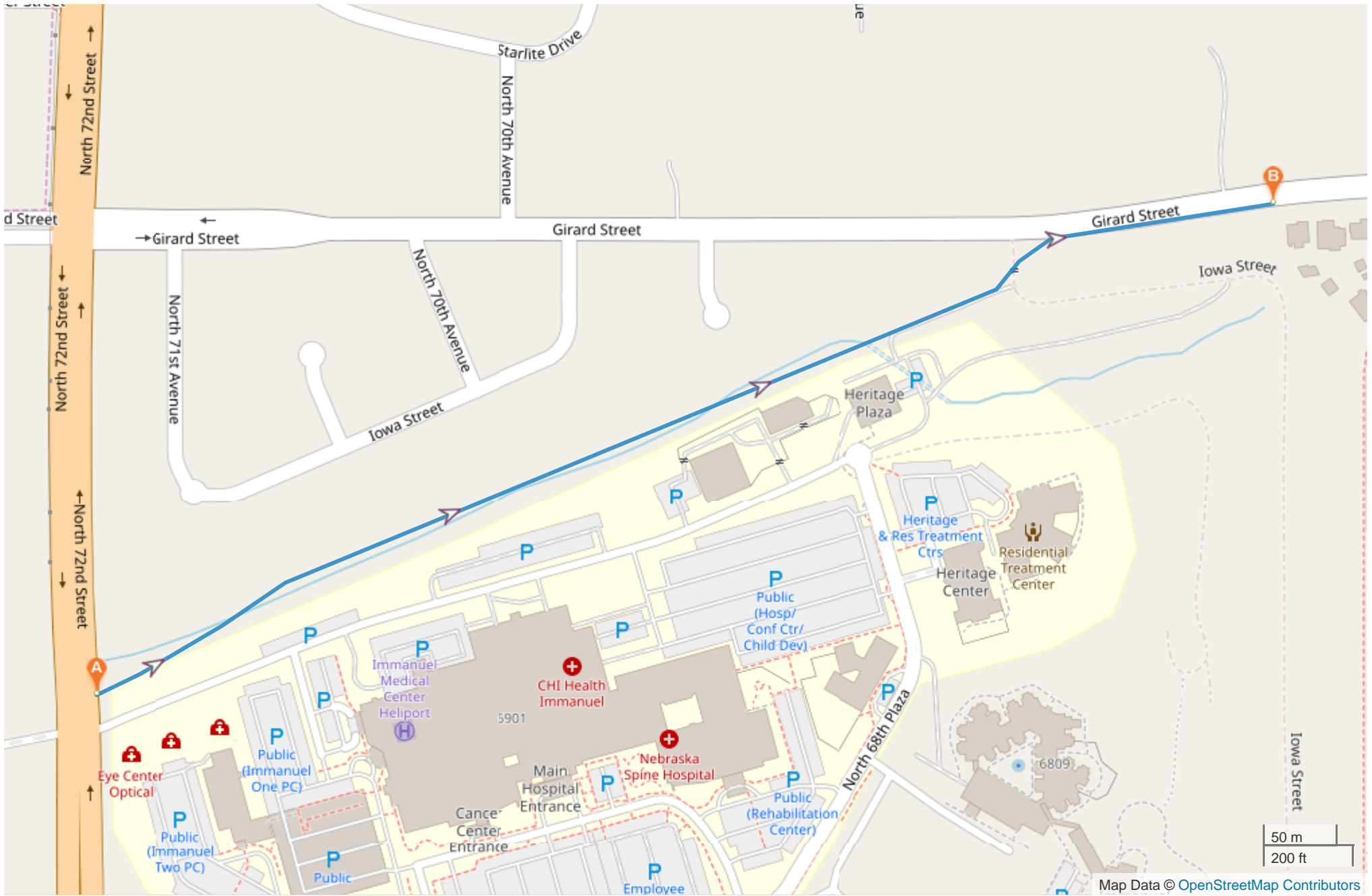
The District approved an Interlocal Agreement with Alegent Health and the City of Omaha for design and construction of the Sorensen to Girard Trail. The project is divided into two sections; east from 72<sup>nd</sup> Street to the existing sidewalk along Girard Street, and west from 72<sup>nd</sup> Street to the north side of Sorensen Parkway. The connection to the east was prioritized to be designed first based on ease of property rights and viability as an independent project. The section to the west will include an underpass at 72<sup>nd</sup> Street, had been awarded federal funding, and is planned to begin after the east connection has been constructed.

A contract for design was executed with Felsburg, Holt & Ullevig (FHU) including bidding and construction administration services from Ehrhart Griffin & Associates (EGA). Bids were solicited beginning in November, with nine (9) bids received and opened on December 18<sup>th</sup>, 2024. The engineers estimate for this project was one million, two hundred thousand, three hundred and two dollars (\$1,200,302.00). Six of the bids were below the estimate, with the low bid from Navarro Lawn & Landscape Inc. (NL&L) at nine hundred nineteen thousand, five hundred twenty-two dollars and seventy cents (\$919,522.70).

Attached is a letter from EGA recommending award of the construction contract to NL&L. Initial construction is anticipated to being in early 2025, and contract documents specify substantial completion by September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2025.

- **Management recommends that the Subcommittee recommend to the Board of Directors that the General Manger be authorized to execute a construction contract with Navarro Lawn & Landscape Inc. (NL&L) in the amount of nine hundred nineteen thousand, five hundred twenty-two dollars and seventy cents (\$919,522.70) for the Sorensen to Girard Trail Project, subject to changes deemed necessary by the General Manger and approval as to form by District Legal Counsel.**

- L G Roloff Construction Co. Inc. submitted a bid totaling \$1,061,902.70.
- Graham Construction Inc. submitted a bid totaling \$1,089,271.70.
- Mackie Construction Inc. submitted a bid totaling \$1,096,311.28.
- M.E. Collins Contracting Co., Inc. submitted a bid totaling \$1,129,341.10.
- Charles Vrana and Son Construction Co. submitted a bid totaling \$1,194,127.60.
- Valley Corporation submitted a bid totaling \$1,221,448.12.
- Mecco-Henne Contracting Inc. submitted a bid totaling \$1,343,022.80.
- RPL Utility LLC submitted a bid totaling \$1,346,378.68.

There were no errors observed in any of the submitted bids.

Based on the bid of \$919,522.70, and related work by the contractor on previous Ehrhart Griffin & Associates projects, we hereby recommend Navarro Lawn & Landscape Inc. be awarded the contract.

Six (6) of the nine (9) bids received were below the Engineers Estimate (\$1,200,302.00) for the project.

contractors doing business in the locality of the Site; information and observations obtained from visits to the Site; the Bidding Documents; and any Site-related reports and drawings identified in the Bidding Documents, with respect to the effect of such information, observations, and documents on (1) the cost, progress, and performance of the Work; (2) the means, methods, techniques, sequences, and procedures of construction to be employed by Bidder; and (3) Bidder's safety precautions and programs.

- F. Bidder agrees, based on the information and observations referred to in the preceding paragraph, that no further examinations, investigations, explorations, tests, studies, or data are necessary for the determination of this Bid for performance of the Work at the price bid and within the times required, and in accordance with the other terms and conditions of the Bidding Documents.
- G. Bidder is aware of the general nature of work to be performed by Owner and others at the Site that relates to the Work as indicated in the Bidding Documents.
- H. Bidder has given Engineer written notice of all conflicts, errors, ambiguities, or discrepancies that Bidder has discovered in the Bidding Documents, and confirms that the written resolution thereof by Engineer is acceptable to Bidder.
- I. The Bidding Documents are generally sufficient to indicate and convey understanding of all terms and conditions for the performance and furnishing of the Work.
- J. The submission of this Bid constitutes an incontrovertible representation by Bidder that Bidder has complied with every requirement of this Article, and that without exception the Bid and all prices in the Bid are premised upon performing and furnishing the Work required by the Bidding Documents.

#### **ARTICLE 4 – BIDDER'S CERTIFICATION**

##### **4.1 Bidder certifies that:**

- A. This Bid is genuine and not made in the interest of or on behalf of any undisclosed individual or entity and is not submitted in conformity with any collusive agreement or rules of any group, association, organization, or corporation;
- B. Bidder has not directly or indirectly induced or solicited any other Bidder to submit a false or sham Bid;
- C. Bidder has not solicited or induced any individual or entity to refrain from bidding; and
- D. Bidder has not engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, or coercive practices in competing for the Contract. For the purposes of this Paragraph 4.01.D:
  - 1. "corrupt practice" means the offering, giving, receiving, or soliciting of any thing of value likely to influence the action of a public official in the bidding process;
  - 2. "fraudulent practice" means an intentional misrepresentation of facts made (a) to influence the bidding process to the detriment of Owner, (b) to establish bid prices at artificial non-competitive levels, or (c) to deprive Owner of the benefits of free and open competition;
  - 3. "collusive practice" means a scheme or arrangement between two or more Bidders, with or without the knowledge of Owner, a purpose of which is to establish bid prices at artificial, non-competitive levels; and



Bidder acknowledges that (1) each Bid Unit Price and Item Lump Sum includes an amount considered by Bidder to be adequate to cover Contractor's overhead and profit for each separately identified item, and (2) estimated quantities are not guaranteed, and are solely for the purpose of comparison of Bids, and final payment for all unit price Bid items will be based on actual quantities, determined as provided in the Contract Documents.
