RE: Contract Amendment 5 with Ehrhart, Griffin & Associates for Beltline Trail


The District signed an Interlocal Agreement with the City of Omaha for design and construction of the Beltline Trail in the area from Hamilton Street at Military Ave, to the Metro transit center north of 31st and Sprague Street. In March 2021, the District contracted with a design team led by Ehrhart Griffin and Associates (EGA) to develop a conceptual plan for the entire corridor, and to identify multiple phases of the project which can be constructed independently. This process allows the District to deliver benefits to residents in our community in a timely fashion. Construction for Phase 1 was completed in 2022, and Phase 2 in 2023. Phase 3A is currently under construction, and Phase 4 will being construction in the summer of 2025. Minor contract Amendments 3, and 4 were within management authority and were previously approved.

Land rights for the length of trail from Hamilton Street to Grant Street were held by several different property owners. Acquisition of larger parcels between Hamilton and Decatur was completed in 2024, while smaller parcels from Decatur to Grant are still in process. Dividing Phase 3 into an A and B bid document package allowed Phase 3A to move to bidding and construction without waiting for the additional year anticipated for the additional property rights to the north. This division of plans required some additional processional services that were not included in the original scope.

Following completion of the design for Phase 3A, specific information about unused land along the trail corridor is now finalized. Preliminary work to determine how this adjacent land can be put to the most beneficial community use requires additional discussion with the City of Omaha Planning Department about platting, and additional professional services.

The recommended amendment to the professional services agreement related to Phase 3A, Phase 3B represents an increase of \$46,780 to the total contract amount.

• Management recommends that the Subcommittee recommend to the Board of Directors that the General Manager be authorized to execute the proposed Amendment No. 5 to the Processional Services Agreement between the District and Ehrhart Griffin & Associates for the Beltline Trail Project for the maximum amount of \$46,780 bringing the total maximum not to exceed contract amount to \$905,914.54, subject to changes deemed necessary by the General Manager and approval as to form by District Legal Counsel.

Dear Mr. Winkler,

As discussed between the Papio-Missouri River Natural Resources District and EGA, Phase 3 of the Beltline Trail project is to be split into two separate sub-phases. Additional services are needed to split the construction documents into two separate sets, apply for the additional required permits, and perform construction management services for the additional phase. Also, additional full-time resident construction observation for the end of Decatur Street is required due to the design of the trail as required by the City of Omaha Public Improvement Permit.

Additionally, it was also requested that the parcels of property that the NRD owns for Phase 3a be re-platted so that the surplus property, which is not needed for the proposed trail, is separated from the property that will be transferred to the City of Omaha. Therefore, a contract amendment is necessary to complete this work.

Below highlights these services and fees to be included in the contract amendment:

• Additional Construction Documents: \$4,500.00

- Split the construction plans that were already mostly completed into two separate phases.
- Adjust the current Phase 3 permits so that they only apply towards Phase 3a.
- Apply for separate permits for Phase 3b.
- Prepare separate specifications for Phase 3b.
- Additional Construction Management Services: \$17,120.00
 - Services during the bidding phase for Phase 3b.
 - Additional construction observation reports for Phase 3b.
 - Additional full time resident construction observation services for the Public Improvements at the end of Decatur Street in Phase 3a.
 - o Additional NPDES Erosion Control inspection reporting for Phase 3b.
 - Pay application review for Phase 3b.
- Additional Project Management: \$960.00
 - Internal project management services.
 - Coordinate the split with subconsultants.
- Platting Services: \$16,000.00
 - Two Administrative Subdivision Plats, including lot pinning.
 - Four Boundary Surveys.
 - One right-of-way dedication description and exhibit.
 - Pre-Application Meeting and other City of Omaha coordination.

• RDG Subconsultant Fee: \$7,500.00

- Services during the bidding phase for Phase 3b.
- Additional construction observation services for Phase 3b.
- Reimbursable: \$700.00
 - Grading Permit Fee.
 - o Milage.
